If all (3) three principal Officers are absent (WM, WP, AM) the Proxy carries all the votes, 1 for WM, 1 for WP, 1 for AM, 1 for the Proxy for a total of $\mathbf{4}$ votes.
If the WM is the only one present, she will cast her 2 votes, 1 vote for WP and 1 vote for the AM for a total of 4 votes.
If the WP is the only one present, he will cast his 2 votes, 1 vote for $W M$ and 1 vote for $A M$ for a total of 4 votes.
If the $\underline{A M}$ is the only one present, she will cast her 1 vote, 1 vote for $W M$ and 1 vote for WP for a total of $\mathbf{3}$ votes.
